

LANDLORD AND TENANT (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to extend the period during which the provisions of Parts II and III of the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1935, as amended by the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1936, shall have effect; for this purpose to amend the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1935, as so amended; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 6th December, 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1938."

(2) The Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1935, as amended by the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1936, and by this Act, may be cited as the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1938.

Amendment of Act No. 67, 1932. 2. The Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1935, as amended by the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1936, is amended by omitting from section twenty-eight the word "thirty-eight" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-nine."
