

# GREATER NEWCASTLE (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 24, 1939.

An Act to amend the Greater Newcastle Act, 1937, in certain respects; to validate certain matters; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd November, 1939.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the “Greater Newcastle (Amendment) Act, 1939.”

Short title.

**2.** (1) No act or proceeding of the Newcastle District Abattoir Board shall be invalidated or prejudiced by reason only of the fact that, at the time when such act or proceeding was done, taken or commenced, there was a vacancy in the office of any one member of the said Board.

(2) Subsection one of this section shall be deemed to have commenced on the twenty-seventh day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twelve.

**3.** (1) The Greater Newcastle Act, 1937, is amended by inserting next after paragraph (h) of subsection two of section twenty-one the following new paragraphs:—

(i) All moneys secured by any debentures, mortgages or other securities given by the Board pursuant

pursuant to section thirteen of the Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, and in force immediately before the appointed day shall be secured, firstly, upon the income of the trading undertaking established under section twenty-two of this Act and, secondly, upon the rates and revenues of the City of Greater Newcastle.

- (j) All loans lawfully made to and all debentures, mortgages or other securities given by the Board pursuant to section thirteen of the Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, and in force immediately before the appointed day shall be deemed to be loans made to and debentures, mortgage-deeds and other securities issued by the Greater Newcastle Council under the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(2) Subsection one of this section shall be deemed to have commenced on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
