

MOTOR VEHICLES (TAXATION) ACT.

An Act to provide for an increase of taxes on motor vehicles and trailers; for this purpose to amend the Motor Vehicles (Taxation) Act, 1924; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 7th November, 1939.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and construction.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Motor Vehicles (Taxation) Act, 1939."

(2) This Act shall be read and construed with the Motor Tax Management Act, 1914, as amended by subsequent Acts, and the Motor Vehicles (Taxation) Act, 1924, as amended by subsequent Acts.

Increase of

2. The amount which constitutes the tax imposed upon motor vehicles by the Motor Vehicles (Taxation) Act, 1924, as amended by subsequent Acts, is hereby, with respect to the tax payable upon motor vehicles the registration or renewal of registration of which takes effect on or after a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette, increased by twelve and one-half per centum.
