

## SUPPLY ACT.

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Act No. 39, 1941.

No. 39, 1941. — An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Unemployment Relief Fund, the Social Services Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, towards the services of the Year 1941-1942. [Assented to, 24th September, 1941.]

Preamble. **W** HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have

have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Seven millions eight hundred and seven thousand nine hundred pounds, that is to say—

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Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Two millions eight hundred and thirty-nine thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Out of the Unemployment Relief Fund, the sum of One million and twenty-eight thousand three hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the services to be provided for out of the Unemployment Relief Fund during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Out of the Social Services Fund, the sum of Four hundred and seventeen thousand three hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the services to be provided for out of the Social Services Fund during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Two millions six hundred and sixty-three thousand nine hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of Eighty-four thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of

October

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October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Six hundred and fifty-seven thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Forty-six thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of Seventy thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions eight hundred and thirty-nine thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been

been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1941-1942. 2. Out of the Unemployment Relief Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million and twenty-eight thousand three hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, to defray the expenses of the services to be provided for out of the Unemployment Relief Fund during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1941-1942. £1,028,300

3. Out of the Social Services Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Four hundred and seventeen thousand three hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, to defray the expenses of the services to be provided for out of the Social Services Fund during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1941-1942. £417,300

4. Out of the Government Railways Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions six hundred and sixty-three thousand nine hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth £2,663,900

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Eighty-four thousand pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, to defray salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1941-1942.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Six hundred and fifty-seven thousand pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways, during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1941-1942.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Forty-six thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth

thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1941-1942. **No. 39, 1941.**

8. Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund there shall <sup>£70,800</sup> and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, <sup>may be issued out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund.</sup> the sum of Seventy thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1941-1942.

9. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Unemployment Relief Fund, the Social Services Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, respectively. <sup>Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.</sup>

10. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said <sup>Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.</sup>
