

MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 11, 1946.

An Act to amend the Medical Practitioners Act, 1938-1939, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 7th January, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Medical Practitioners (Amendment) Act, 1945."

(2) The Medical Practitioners Act, 1938, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act may be cited as the Medical Practitioners Act, 1938-1945.

2. The Medical Practitioners Act, 1938-1939, is amended—

(a) (i) by inserting in subparagraph (i) of paragraph (c) of subsection one of section seventeen after the words "which is" the words "or was";

(b) by inserting after section 17A the following new section:—

17B. (1) This section shall commence upon the date upon which the National Security (Alien Doctors) Regulations made under the National Security Act 1939-1943 of the Parliament of the Commonwealth cease to have effect.

(2) In addition to the persons mentioned in sections sixteen, seventeen and 17A of this Act, a person shall be entitled to be registered who

who proves to the satisfaction of the Board that immediately before the commencement of this section—

- (a) he was the holder of a license granted under regulation 10 of the National Security (Alien Doctors) Regulations referred to in subsection one of this section; and
- (b) he was practising medicine in the State of New South Wales in pursuance of such license.

(3) The provisions of subsections six and seven of section seventeen of this Act shall extend to and in respect of the registration of persons possessing the qualifications referred to in subsection two of this section.

The provisions of subsection six of section eighteen of this Act shall not apply to or in respect of a person who proves that he possesses the qualifications referred to in subsection two of this section.
