

LANDLORD AND TENANT (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 3, 1946.

An Act to extend the period during which the provisions of Parts II and III of the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1943, shall have effect; for this purpose to amend the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1943; and for purposes connected therewith. BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1945." Short title and citation.

(2) The Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1945.
