

CO-OPERATION (FURTHER AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 18, 1947.

George VI. An Act to amend the Co-operation Act, 1923-
No. 18, 1947. 1947; to validate certain matters; and for
purposes connected therewith. [Assented
to 10th November, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, No. 18, 1947. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Co-operation (Further Amendment) Act, 1947." Short title, citation and commencement.

(2) The Co-operation, Community Settlement, and Credit Act, 1923, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Co-operation Acts, 1923-1947.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.

2. The Co-operation Act, 1923-1947, is amended by omitting from subsection four of section 17A the words "seven hundred and fifty thousand pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one million two hundred and fifty thousand pounds." Amendment of Act No. 1, 1924. Sec. 17A. (Colonial Treasurer may undertake to indemnify building societies against loss in certain circumstances.)
