No. 26, 1947. An Act to amend the Kosciusko State Park Act, 1944, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 5th December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Kosciusko State Park (Amendment) Act, 1947."

(2) The Kosciusko State Park Act, 1944, as amended by this Act may be cited as the Kosciusko State Park Act, 1944-1947.
