

GEORGE'S RIVER BRIDGE (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 33, 1947.

George VI.
No. 33, 1947. An Act to amend the George's River Bridge Act, 1923, the Main Roads Act, 1924-1945, and certain other Acts in certain respects; to validate certain matters; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 10th December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "George's River Bridge (Amendment) Act, 1947."
(2) The George's River Bridge Act, 1923, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the George's River Bridge Act, 1923-1947.

2. (1) The George's River Bridge Act, 1923, is No. 33, 1947.
amended:—

(a) by inserting next after section ten the following
new section:—

10A. (1) This section shall be deemed to have
commenced upon the sixth day of November,
one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, and
shall have effect notwithstanding anything
contained in this or any other Act.

(2) All works of construction, main-
tenance and repair in connection with the
bridge (other than lighting of the bridge) shall
be carried out by the Commissioner for Main
Roads under the provisions of the Main Roads
Act, 1924-1945, and for such purposes the
bridge shall be deemed to be part of the Prince's
Highway (State Highway No. 1).

(3) The amount (if any) by which the
moneys held in the special bank account referred
to in section ten of this Act at the commence-
ment of this section exceeds the liabilities
incurred in respect of the purposes specified in
the said section ten and outstanding at the
commencement of this section, and all moneys
received after such commencement from tolls
or charges imposed under this Act and paid
into such special bank account shall, as from
such commencement, be applied towards the
cost of the collection of tolls and charges and
the lighting of the bridge.

Any surplus in such account shall be paid not
less frequently than every six months to the
Colonial Treasurer in or towards repayment of
any moneys with interest thereon due by the
Council of the Shire of Sutherland to the
Colonial Treasurer pursuant to the provisions
of the George's River Bridge (Guarantee) Act,
1925, or the George's River Bridge (Further
Guarantee) Act, 1928.

(b) (i) by inserting in subsection one of section eleven after the words "is satisfied that" the words "all moneys with interest thereon due by the Council of the Shire of Sutherland to the Colonial Treasurer pursuant to the provisions of the George's River Bridge (Guarantee) Act, 1925, or the George's River Bridge (Further Guarantee) Act, 1928, and";

(ii) by omitting paragraph (b) of subsection two of the same section and by inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraphs:—

(b) the bridge shall become and be part of the Prince's Highway (State Highway No. 1);

(c) all moneys received by the council under this Act and held by the council at the date of the publication of such notification in the Gazette shall be paid into the County of Cumberland Main Roads Fund constituted under the Main Roads Act, 1924-1945, and the bridge shall thereafter be maintained, managed and administered by the Commissioner for Main Roads under that Act.

(2) (a) The George's River Bridge (Guarantee) Act, 1925, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section four the words "at the rate of six per centum per annum" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "at such rate not exceeding six per centum per annum as the Colonial Treasurer may from time to time determine".

(b) The George's River Bridge (Further Guarantee) Act, 1928, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section five the words "at the rate of six per centum per annum" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "at such rate not exceeding six per centum per annum as the Colonial Treasurer may from time to time determine".

(c) The amendments made by paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection shall be deemed to have commenced upon the twenty-first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, and the sixteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight respectively.
