An Act to amend the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1945, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 19th December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1947.”

(2) The Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Act, 1932-1947.
