

FRIENDLY SOCIETIES DISPENSARIES ENABLING (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 27, 1948.

An Act to amend the Friendly Societies Dispensaries Enabling Act, 1945; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th August, 1948.] George VI.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Friendly Societies Dispensaries Enabling (Amendment) Act, 1948." Short title

(2) The Friendly Societies Dispensaries Enabling Act, 1945, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Friendly Societies Dispensaries Enabling Act, 1945-1948.

2. The Friendly Societies Dispensaries Enabling Act, 1945, is amended— Amendment
of Act No.
11, 1945.

(a) by omitting from subsection two of section one the words "Such day shall not be earlier than the date fixed for the commencement of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Act 1944 of the Parliament of the Commonwealth"; Sec. 1 (2).
(Commence-
ment.)

(b) (i) by omitting from subsection one of section two the figures "1940" and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1946"; Sec. 2.
(Dispensaries—
open shop.)

(ii) by omitting from the same subsection the figures "1942" and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1948";

(iii) by omitting from the same subsection the word "March" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "August".
