

GAS AND ELECTRICITY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 46, 1949.

George VI. An Act to amend the Gas and Electricity Act,
No. 46, 1949. 1935-1948, in certain respects; and for
purposes connected therewith. [Assented
to, 21st November, 1949.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Gas and Electricity (Amendment) Act, 1949".

(2) The Gas and Electricity Act, 1935, as amended
by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the
Gas and Electricity Act, 1935-1949.

Amendment of Act No. 42, 1935. 2. (1) The Gas and Electricity Act, 1935-1948, is amended—

Section 12 (Standard price.) (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection two of section twelve the word "shall" where firstly occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "may";

Section 14 (Inquiry as to standard price or prices.) (b) by omitting from subsection one of section fourteen the word "shall" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "may";

Section 15. (Local authorities.) (c) by omitting from subsection one of section fifteen the word "shall" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "may";

Section 16. (Power to require guarantees, etc.) (d) by omitting from section sixteen the word "shall" where firstly occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "may".

this section shall be deemed to have commenced upon
the sixth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and
forty-nine.
