

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT (FURTHER AMENDMENT) ACT.

**Act No. 38, 1951.**

**George VI.** An Act to authorise local government authorities  
**No. 38, 1951.** to expend moneys from their funds upon the  
forthcoming Royal visit; for this purpose to  
amend the Local Government Act, 1919, and  
the Gas and Electricity Act, 1935-1949; and  
for purposes connected therewith. [Assented  
to, 5th December, 1951.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and Legislative Assembly of New South  
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—

**Short title  
and  
construction.** **1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Local Government (Further Amendment) Act, 1951".

(2) This Act shall be read and construed with the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts.

visit.** **2.** Each of the following authorities, that is to say, the council of any city, municipality or shire, the Sydney County Council, or any county council is hereby empowered

empowered to expend from its funds such moneys as it No. 38, 1951. thinks fit for the purpose of promoting any function, entertainment, pageant or display arranged in connection with the visit which Their Royal Highnesses Princess Elizabeth and the Duke of Edinburgh propose to make to New South Wales during the year one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.
