

## GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS (SUPERANNUATION) AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 48, 1951.

**[George VI.** An Act to increase superannuation allowances  
No. 48, 1951. payable from and deductions from salaries  
to be credited to the Government Railways  
Superannuation Account; for these purposes  
to amend the Government Railways Act,  
1912-1951; and for purposes connected  
therewith. [Assented to, 17th December,  
1951.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and Legislative Assembly of New South  
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Government  
Railways (Superannuation) Amendment Act, 1951."

(2) The Government Railways Act, 1912, as  
amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act may be  
cited as the Government Railways Acts, 1912-1951.

**2.** (1) The Government Railways Act, 1912-1951 is  
amended—

(a) by inserting next after section one hundred and  
eleven the following new section:—

111A. As on and from the sixth day of January,  
one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, the  
deductions

deductions specified in section one hundred and **No. 48, 1951.**  
eleven of this Act shall be increased by an  
amount equal to ten per centum thereof.

(b) by inserting next after section 114A the following <sup>New sec.</sup>  
<sup>114B.</sup> new section:—

114B. (1) Where any superannuation allowance calculated in accordance with the provisions of this Part of this Act is at the commencement of this section payable to, or after such commencement becomes payable to, any officer under this Part of this Act, such allowance, shall, as from such commencement or as from the date upon which such officer becomes entitled to such allowance, as the case may be, be increased by one-fifth, or twenty-six pounds per annum, whichever is the greater.

(2) This section shall take effect as on and from the sixth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.

(c) by omitting subsection one of section one hundred and fifteen and by inserting in lieu <sup>Sec. 115.</sup> <sup>(Payment by officer of deductions appropriate to his superannuation allowance.)</sup> thereof the following subsection:—

(1) An officer who has not contributed during his service, whether such service is before or after the sixth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, a sum equivalent to the total of the following amounts, that is to say:—

(a) an amount equivalent to one and one-half per centum of the average determined under section one hundred and fourteen of this Act as the basis for the computation of the superannuation allowance payable to such officer pursuant to the said section, multiplied, in the case of an officer with less than forty years' service, by the number of complete years of his service, and in the case

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case of an officer with forty years' service or with more than forty years' service by forty; and

(b) an amount equivalent to ten per centum of the said average referred to in paragraph (a) of this subsection multiplied by the number of complete years of service after the sixth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, or forty, whichever is the less,

shall pay to the Government Railways Superannuation Account the difference between such sum and the amount of the deductions made pursuant to sections one hundred and eleven and 111A of this Act.

(2) The amendment made by paragraph (c) of subsection one of this section shall commence upon the sixth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.

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
