

## UNIVERSITY AND UNIVERSITY COLLEGES (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 51, 1952.

**No. 51, 1952.** An Act to amend the University and University Colleges Act, 1900–1951, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.  
[Assented to, 3rd December, 1952.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**Short title and citation.** **1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "University and University Colleges (Amendment) Act, 1952."

(2) The University and University Colleges Act, 1900, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the University and University Colleges Act, 1900–1952.

1951, is amended by inserting at the end of section 31A of Act No.  
the following new subsection:—<sup>22, 1900.</sup>

**Sec. 31A.**

(5) After the commencement of the University (Public  
and University Colleges (Amendment) Act, 1952, and <sup>exhibitions.</sup>)  
until a day to be appointed by the Governor and  
notified by proclamation published in the Gazette, it  
shall not be necessary for the Senate to allot public  
exhibitions pursuant to this section.
