

## LIBRARY AND ART GALLERY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

---

**Act No. 60, 1952.**

Elizabeth II  
No. 60, 1952. An Act to amend the Library and Art Gallery Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 9th December, 1952.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title,

commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Library and Art Gallery (Amendment) Act, 1952".

(2) The Library and Art Gallery Act, 1899, as No. 60, 1952, amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Library and Art Gallery Act, 1899-1952.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.

**2.** The Library and Art Gallery Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting section thirty-two and by inserting in lieu thereof the following section:—

32. Nothing contained in the Stamp Duties Act, 1920, or in any Act amending the said Act, whether passed before or after the commencement of the Library and Art Gallery (Amendment) Act, 1952, shall apply to any real or personal property of any nature or kind whatsoever comprised in any gift inter vivos, devise or bequest made or to be made to the library or gallery or the trustees of the library or gallery.
