

SUPPLY ACT.

Act No. 3, 1953.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund, towards the services of the Year 1953-1954. [Assented to, 25th September, 1953.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Twenty-seven millions nine hundred and thirteen thousand five hundred pounds, that is to say—

Preamble.

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Thirteen millions four hundred and fifty-one thousand one hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.

Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Eleven millions five hundred and fifty-three thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses
of

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of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of two hundred and eighty-nine thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport and the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two millions and fourteen thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two hundred and thirty-two thousand three hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of Two hundred and seventy-one thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and eighty-nine thousand seven hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport and the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1953-1954.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two millions and fourteen thousand pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1953-1954.

5. Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and thirty-two thousand three hundred pounds to be expended

at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1953-1954.

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6. Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and seventy-one thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1953-1954.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of One hundred and one thousand six hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1953-1954.

8. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund, respectively.

9. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders, and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Short title.

10. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1953."
