

NEW SOUTH WALES GOVERNMENT ENGINEERING AND SHIPBUILDING UNDERTAKING AND ELECTRICITY COMMISSION ACT.

An Act to make provision whereby the present Director of the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking may be continued in office for a certain period as such Director and also as a Commissioner of the Electricity Commission of New South Wales; for this purpose to amend the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act, 1943, and the Electricity Commission Act, 1950-1954; and for purposes connected therewith [Assented to, 20th April, 1954.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

Director of State Dock-yard to be eligible for re-appointment.

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking and Electricity Commission Act, 1954."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act, 1943, David Lyon McLarty may, upon the expiration, by effluxion of time, of the term of office which he holds at the commencement of this Act as Director of the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking, be re-appointed as such Director from time to time.

For the purposes of this section the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act, 1943, shall be deemed to be amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subsection four of section five the words "sixty-five years" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "sixty-eight years".

3. Subsection six of section five of the Electricity No. 16, 1954 Commission Act, 1950-1954, shall, in its application to David Lyon McLarty in his capacity as a Commissioner under the said Act, be deemed to be amended by omitting from subsection six of section five the words "sixty-five years" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "sixty-eight years".

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Electricity Commission Act, 1950-1954, the said David Lyon McLarty may, upon the expiration, by effluxion of time, of the term of office which he holds at the commencement of this Act as a Commissioner under the said Act, be re-appointed as such a Commissioner.
