

COMPANIES (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 2, 1955.

Elizabeth II, An Act to repeal subsection six of section thirty-four of the Companies Act, 1936, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 8th March, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
