

## DAIRY INDUSTRY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to make certain provision in relation to the amount of table margarine that may be manufactured under license; for this purpose to amend the Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1951, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 13th December, 1955.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dairy Industry (Amendment) Act, 1955."

(2) The Dairy Industry Act, 1915, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1955.

**2.** The Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1951, is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subsection six of section 22A the words "two thousand five hundred tons" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "nine thousand tons".
