

WINE ADULTERATION (REPEAL) ACT.

Act No. 9, 1955.

Elizabeth II, No. 9, 1955. An Act to repeal the Wine Adulteration Act, 1902, and the Wine Adulteration Amendment Act, 1916, and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 9th March, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Wine Adulteration (Repeal) Act, 1955."

(2) This Act shall commence upon a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.
