

**TRANSPORT (DIVISION OF FUNCTIONS)  
COMMISSIONER FOR RAILWAYS ACT.**

**Act No. 2, 1956.**

**Elizabeth II,** An Act to make further provision relating to the office of Commissioner for Railways; for this purpose to amend the Transport (Division of Functions) Act, 1932, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 31st July, 1956.]

BE

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, No. 2, 1956. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Transport (Division of Functions) Commissioner for Railways Act, 1956." Short title.

**2.** The Transport (Division of Functions) Act, 1932, Amendment of Act No. 31, 1932, sec. 7. as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting at the end of subsection one of section seven the following proviso:—

Provided that in the application of paragraph (b) of this subsection to and in respect of the Commissioner for Railways the said paragraph (b) shall be deemed to be amended by omitting therefrom the words "a period of seven years" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "such period, not exceeding seven years, as may be specified in the instrument of his appointment". (Appointment of Commissioners.)
