

VETERINARY SURGEONS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 8, 1957.

Elizabeth II, An Act to extend certain temporary provisions
No. 8, 1957. of the Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1923-1952;
for this purpose to amend the said Act; and
for purposes connected therewith. [Assented
to, 29th March, 1957.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Veterinary
Surgeons (Amendment) Act, 1957".

(2) The Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1923, as amended
by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the
Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1923-1957.

Amendment of Act No. 25, 1923. 2. The Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1923-1952, is
amended—

See. 13. (Qualifications for registration.) (a) by omitting from subparagraph (iii) of paragraph (c) of subsection one of section thirteen the words "five years" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "fifteen years";

See. 24. (Minor and urgent operations.) (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) of section twenty-four the words "five years" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "fifteen years".
