

MEAT INDUSTRY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 44, 1958.

An Act to make provision whereby the present chair- Elizabeth II,
No. 44, 1958. man of the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board may be continued in office for a certain period as a member of that Board; for this purpose to amend the Meat Industry Act, 1915, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 31st December, 1958.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Meat Industry (Amendment) Act, 1958". Short title.
2. Paragraph (b) of subsection one of section 8A of the Meat Industry Act, 1915, as amended by subsequent Acts, shall, in its application to Thomas Michael McGrath in his capacity as a member of the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board constituted under that Act, as so amended, be deemed to be amended by omitting therefrom the words "sixty-five years" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "sixty-seven years". of Thomas Michael McGrath's term of office as a member of the Board.
