

## **SUPPLY ACT.**

---

### **Act No. 31, 1963.**

**Elizabeth II, An** Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated  
**No. 31, 1963** Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Maritime Services Board Fund and the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, towards the services of the Year 1963-1964.  
[Assented to, 13th September, 1963.]

WHEREAS

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Forty-five millions and fifty-seven thousand nine hundred pounds, that is to say—

Preamble.

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Twenty-seven millions one hundred and thirty-three thousand two hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Thirteen millions three hundred and eight thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

Out of the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the sum of Three hundred and ninety-one thousand six hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of Eight hundred and forty thousand six hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two millions one hundred thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two hundred and forty-two thousand five hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

Out of the Maritime Services Board Fund, the sum of Eight hundred and fifty-four thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

Out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, the sum of One hundred and eighty-six thousand five hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to Your Majesty : Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the  
advice

advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Twenty-seven millions one hundred and thirty-three thousand two hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1963-1964.

2. Out of the Government Railways Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Thirteen millions three hundred and eight thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1963-1964.

Out of the Government Railways Renewals Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Three hundred and ninety-one thousand six hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year

**4.** Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Eight hundred and forty thousand six hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1963-1964.

**5.** Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two millions one hundred thousand pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1963-1964.

**6.** Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and forty-two thousand five hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November  
or

or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1963-1964. **No. 31, 1963**

7. Out of the Maritime Services Board Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Eight hundred and fifty-four thousand seven hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1963-1964. £854,700 may be issued out of the Maritime Services Board Fund.

8. Out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of One hundred and eighty-six thousand five hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1963-1964. £186,500 may be issued out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund.

9. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

**10.** The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders, and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

**11.** This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1963."
