

## DRIED FRUITS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to increase the maximum sum which may be required to be contributed annually to the New South Wales Dried Fruits Board by the person in whose name a packing house is registered under the Dried Fruits Act, 1939, as amended by subsequent Acts; for this purpose to amend that Act, as so amended; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 1st April, 1964.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows : —
