Act No. 36, 1970.

An Act to make provision for an increase in the salary of the Governor of New South Wales; for this purpose to amend the Governor's Salary Act, 1901, and the Constitution Act, 1902; and for purposes connected therewith. [Reserved, 13th April, 1970. Assent proclaimed, 24th July, 1970.]

Governor's Salary (Amendment).

— **B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and commencement. **1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Governor's Salary (Amendment) Act, 1970".

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and seventy.

Amendment of Act No. 40, 1901.
Sec. 2.
(Amount of Governor's salary and salaries of his staff.) **2.** The Governor's Salary Act, 1901, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section two the words "twenty thousand" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-three thousand".
