**Act No. 24, 1971.**

An Act to enable grants, loans or advances to be made from the Closer Settlement and Public Reserves Fund in respect of public reserves, whether or not subject to any trust; for this purpose to amend the Closer Settlement and Public Reserves Fund Act, 1970; and for purposes connected therewith.  
[Assented to, 27th September, 1971.]

*Closer Settlement and Public Reserves Fund (Amendment).*

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 24, 1971 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Closer Settlement and Public Reserves Fund (Amendment) Act, 1971". Short title.

2. The Closer Settlement and Public Reserves Fund Act, 1970, is amended by inserting in section three next after the definition of "Public reserve" the following new definition :— Amendment of Act No. 26, 1970.

"Trustees" includes any persons having the care, control and management of a public reserve, whether or not subject to any trust. Sec. 3. (Interpretation.)
