Act No. 51, 1971.

An Act to make provision for an increase in the annual subsidy payable to the Wild Dog Destruction Fund established under the Wild Dog Destruction Act, 1921; for this purpose to amend that Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th December, 1971.]

BE

Wild Dog Destruction (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 51, 1971 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Wild Dog Destruction Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1971".

2. The Wild Dog Destruction Act, 1921, is amended by Amendment of omitting section eighteen and by inserting in lieu thereof the Act No. 17, 1921.

18. Commencing in the year one thousand nine ^{Payment of} hundred and seventy-one, for any year in which rates ^{subsidy.} have been collected there shall be paid, without further appropriation than this Act, from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Wild Dog Destruction Fund established under this Act a sum equal to one hundred per centum of the amount of the rates collected during the year or the sum of sixty thousand dollars, whichever is the lesser.
