An Act to continue the operation of the Commonwealth Places (Administration of Laws) Act, 1970, for three years; for this and other purposes to amend that Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th December, 1971.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the "Commonwealth Places (Administration of Laws) Amendment Act, 1971".
