Act No. 54, 1972.

An Act to extend the period in each year during which standard time is advanced to summer time; for this purpose to amend the Standard Time Act, 1971; and for purposes connected therewith.
[Assented to, 17th October, 1972.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Standard Time Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1972".

3. The Standard Time Act, 1971, is amended—
(a) by omitting from section 5 (1) the words “last Sunday in the month of February” and by inserting instead the words “first Sunday in the month of March”;
(b) by omitting section 5 (5).
