**Act No. 26, 1973.**

An Act to enable the Grain Elevators Board of New South Wales to store and handle certain products other than grain; to vary the basis upon which that Board holds or receives or acquires moneys or other property; for these purposes to amend the Grain Elevators Act, 1954; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd May, 1973.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 26, 1973 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Grain Elevators Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1973".

2. The Grain Elevators Act, 1954, is amended—

(a) (i) by omitting from section 23 (1A) the words "store grain other than wheat and for matters incidental to such use" and by inserting instead the following words :—

store and handle—

(a) grain other than wheat;

(b) seed; or

(c) products manufactured from plant material,

and for matters incidental thereto;

(ii) by inserting in section 23 (2) after the word "wheat" the words "or of seed or plant material";

(b) by inserting next after section 49 the following new section :—

49A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act—

(a) any moneys or other property held by the Board immediately before the commencement of the Grain Elevators (Amendment) Act, 1973, are or is, on and after that
