Act No. 28, 1975.

An Act to make further provisions with respect to the appointment of persons to the Teaching Service; for this purpose to amend the Teaching Service Act, 1970; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th April, 1975.]

BE

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 28, 1975 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Teaching Service Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1975".
2. The Teaching Service Act, 1970, is amended by Amendment of Act No. 4, 1970. inserting after section 24 the following section :—
Sec. 24A.

24A. In making an appointment to an office under Appointments under section 23 or 24. the Director-General may, notwithstanding any other law (including any order or award 23 or 24. made under any Act), select for the appointment a person who has the appropriate qualifications and—

 - (a) who—
 - (i) has a prior contract with the Director-General for his employment in an office in the Teaching Service; or
 - (ii) under a contract with Her Majesty may, in the circumstances specified in the contract, be required to enter upon duty in an office in the Teaching Service; or
 - (b) who, in the opinion of the Director-General, is the most suitable person for appointment to that office.
