An Act to amend the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, in relation to the age at which persons may make a bet or wager and to remove a restriction on the publication of information concerning certain totalizator dividends.

Gaming and Betting (Amendment).

No. 81, 1975

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and Betting (Amendment) Act, 1975".

(1) Section 1—

Omit "infants", insert instead "persons under the age of 18 years".

(2) (a) Section 10, short heading—

Omit "infants", insert instead "persons under the age of 18 years".

(b) Section 10 (a)—

Omit "twenty-one years", insert instead "18 years".

Omit “twenty-one years” wherever occurring, insert instead “18 years”.

(4) Section 13—

Omit “twenty-one years” wherever occurring, insert instead “18 years”.

(5) Section 14—

Omit “twenty-one years”, insert instead “18 years”.

(6) (a) Section 47F—

Omit “, at any time after an event or contingency on which bets have been made through the Totalizer Agency Board under and in accordance with the Totalizer (Off-course Betting) Act, 1964, has taken place or been decided,”.

(b) Section 47F—

Omit “payable in respect of such bets made on such event or contingency”, insert instead “or probable totalizer dividends payable in respect of bets made through the Totalizer Agency Board under and in accordance with the Totalizer (Off-course Betting) Act, 1964, on an event or contingency”.
