Act No. 49, 1976.

An Act to repeal the Department of Agriculture Act, 1907.
[Assented to, 27th October, 1976.]

BE

Department of Agriculture (Repeal).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Department of Agriculture (Repeal) Act, 1976". Short title.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on Commencement. the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Sections 3, 4 and 5 shall be deemed to have commenced on 14th May, 1976.

3. The Department of Agriculture Act, 1907, is repealed. Repeal of Act No. 6, 1907.

4. Notwithstanding section 3, but subject to section 5, Continuance of Department of Agriculture. the Department of Agriculture shall continue to exist under the management and control of the Minister administering Agriculture. section 5 of the Marketing of Primary Products Act, 1927.

5. Nothing in this Act affects any power—

Certain powers not affected.

(a) to create or abolish, or change the title of, any Ministerial office, or to appoint a person to be a Minister of the Crown by a particular title; or

(b) to establish or abolish, or change the title of, any Department of the Government.
