Act No. 59, 1976.

An Act to amend section 4 of the Wheat Industry Stabilization Act, 1974, in relation to the definition of "wheat products". [Assented to, 27th October, 1976.]

BE

Wheat Industry Stabilization (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Wheat Industry ~~Short title.~~ Stabilization (Amendment) Act, 1976".

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on ~~Commencement~~ the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3 shall be deemed to have commenced on 3rd May, 1976.

3. The Wheat Industry Stabilization Act, 1974, is ~~Amendment~~ amended by omitting the definition of "wheat products" in ~~of Act No.~~ 108, 1974. section 4 and by inserting instead the following definition:— ~~Sec. 4.~~

"wheat products" means a substance (other than bran or pollard) produced by the gristing, crushing, grinding, milling or other processing of wheat, and includes—

(a) any of the following products made from wheat, namely, flour, semolina, sharps, wheatmeal, starch, gluten, rice substitutes and breakfast foods; and

(b) any other commodity—

(i) that is produced mainly from other wheat products or from wheat; or

(ii)

- (ii) that is produced partly from other wheat products or from wheat and is declared by regulations made under the Wheat Export Charge Act 1974 of the Parliament of the Commonwealth to be a wheat product for the purposes of that Act.
