Act No. 8, 1976.

An Act to amend the Radioactive Substances Act, 1957.

[Assented to, 24th March, 1976.]

BE

Radioactive Substances (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the "Radioactive Substances (Amendment) Act, 1976".

Commencement. 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3 (b) shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

Amendment of Act No. 5, 1957. 3. The Radioactive Substances Act, 1957, is amended—

Sec. 8. (Powers of inspectors and members of Council.) (a) by inserting in section 8 (1) (a) after the words "and examine" the word ", test";

Sec. 10. (Prohibition on possession, use or sale of irradiating apparatus.) (b) by omitting section 10 (1) (a) and (b) and by inserting instead the following paragraphs:—

(a) have in his possession;

(b) use; or

(c) sell,

Radioactive Substances (Amendment).

- (c) by inserting in section 11 (1) (a) after the word Sec. 11, "shall" where secondly occurring the words (Licenses.) "except in such cases or classes of cases as may be approved by the Commission";
- (d) by inserting in section 18 (1) (f) after the word Sec. 18, "substance" the words "or irradiating apparatus". (Regulations.)
