Act No. 55, 1978.

An Act to amend the Meat Industry Act, 1915, so as to provide for the extension of the term of office of the present representative on the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board of persons employed in the meat industry. [Assented to, 3rd April, 1978.]

Meat Industry (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Meat Industry (Amendment) Short title. Act, 1978”.

2. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of the Meat Industry Act, 1915, or the Meat Industry Act, 1978, the Governor may appoint Reginald Brownlee, Esquire, to hold office as the member of the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board representative of persons employed in the meat industry for a period expiring on 31st December, 1978. Extension of Reginald Brownlee's term of office as a member of the Board.

(2) Section 8A (1) (b) of the Meat Industry Act, 1915, and clause 6 (1) (c) of Schedule 3 to the Meat Industry Act, 1978, shall be construed, in relation to Reginald Brownlee, Esquire, as if the reference therein to the age of 65 years were a reference to his age on 31st December, 1978.
