An Act to repeal the Dental Hospitals Union Act, 1904, the Dental Hospitals Union (Amendment) Act, 1932, and so much of Schedule 1 to the Statute Law Revision Act, 1976, as amends the Dental Hospitals Union (Amendment) Act, 1932. [Assented to, 12th April, 1978.]

Dental Hospitals Union (Repeal).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Dental Hospitals Union (Repeal) Act, 1978".

Commencement.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day upon which an order is published under section 4 (2) of the Public Hospitals Act, 1929, adding to the Second Schedule to that Act the name of the United Dental Hospital of Sydney.
