An Act to amend section 44A of the Legal Practitioners Act, 1898;
as a consequence of the enactment of the Legal Services
Commission Act, 1979. [Assented to, 16th May, 1979.]

Legal Practitioners (Legal Services Commission) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners (Legal Services Commission) Amendment Act, 1979". Short title.

2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commence-
ment.

(2) Section 3 shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (3) of the Legal Services Commission Act, 1979.

3. The Legal Practitioners Act, 1898, is amended by omitting section 44A (2) (a) and by inserting instead the following paragraph :— Amendment

22, 1898.
