Act No. 114, 1980.

An Act to amend section 28 of the Wheat Marketing Act, 1979,
to revise references to Commonwealth Police Officers.
[Assented to, 22nd October, 1980.]

Wheat Marketing (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Wheat Marketing (Amendment) Act, 1980”. Short title.

2. The Wheat Marketing Act, 1979, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from section 28 (1) the words “Commonwealth Police Officer, a member of the police force of a State or Territory” and by inserting instead the words “police officer”;
- (b) by omitting from section 28 (3) and (4) the words “Commonwealth Police Officer or a member of the police force of a State or Territory” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the words “police officer”;
- (c) by omitting from section 28 (4) the words “Officer or member of the police force” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the words “police officer”;
- (d) by omitting section 28 (9) and by inserting instead the following subsection :—

(9) In this section—

“occupier”, in relation to any premises, includes a person in charge of those premises;

of a State or Territory or a member of the
Australian Federal Police.
