An Act to amend section 219 of the Transport Act, 1930, to
increase the penalty for certain offences. [Assented to, 9th
December, 1980.]

Transport (Further Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Transport (Further Amendment) Act, 1980”. Short title.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commence-
ment.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Government Railways (Further Amendment) Act, 1980.

3. The Transport Act, 1930, is amended by omitting from section 219 (1) the words “twenty dollars” and by inserting instead the matter “\$200”. Amendment
