Act No. 75, 1981.

An Act to amend paragraph 2 (a) of the Schedule to the Workmen's Compensation (Broken Hill) Act, 1920, to include a definition of "widow" for the purposes of that Schedule. [Assented to, 28th May, 1981.]

Workmen's Compensation (Broken Hill) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Workmen's Compensation (Broken Hill) Amendment Act, 1981".

Amendment of Act No. 36, 1920.

2. The Workmen's Compensation (Broken Hill) Act, 1920, is amended by inserting after the definition of "The Fund" in paragraph 2 (a) of the Schedule the following definition:—

"Widow" includes a woman who was not legally married to the deceased, but who, in the lifetime of the deceased, lived with him as his wife on a permanent and bona fide domestic basis.
