Act No. 131, 1982.

An Act to amend section 27 of the Medical Practitioners Act, 1938, in relation to medical practitioners convicted of offences under Part IV of the Private Health Establishments Act, 1982. [Assented to, 15th December, 1982.]

Medical Practitioners (Private Health Establishments) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Medical Practitioners (Private Health Establishments) Amendment Act, 1982".

Commencement.

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Private Health Establishments Act, 1982.

Amendment of Act No. 37, 1938.

3. The Medical Practitioners Act, 1938, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

AMENDMENTS TO THE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS ACT, 1938.

(1) Section 27 (2) (d)—

Omit "or" where lastly occurring.

(2) Section 27 (2) (e)—

Omit “or (4).”, insert instead “or (4); or”.

(3) Section 27 (2) (f)—

After section 27 (2) (e), insert:—

- (f) commits an offence against a provision of Part IV of the Private Health Establishments Act, 1982, of which he is convicted.
