

**Act No. 73, 1992**

An Act to amend the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 to increase the fees paid for licences under that Act. [Assented to 23 November 1992]

**The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:****Short title**

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Amendment Act 1992.

**Commencement**

**2.** This Act commences or is taken to have commenced on 1 October 1992.

**Amendment of Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 No. 94, s. 40 (Fees)**

**3.** The Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 is amended by omitting section 40 (3) and by inserting instead the following subsection:

(3) For the purposes of subsection (1), the prescribed proportion is:

- (a) in respect of motor spirit—9.07 per cent; and
- (b) in respect of diesel fuel—15.1 per cent.

**Application of Act**

**4.** The amendment made by this Act applies to and in respect of a fee for a licence taking effect on or after 1 November 1992.
