

NSW Government Gazette Information

The *New South Wales Government Gazette* is the permanent public record of official notices issued by the New South Wales Government. It also contains local council and other notices where there is a legislative requirement for gazettal.

The Gazette is compiled and published in PDF versions by the Parliamentary Counsel's Office. It is published every Friday (except public holidays) on the NSW legislation website (www.legislation.nsw.gov.au), but for urgent matters may be published on other days.

From September 2020, the Gazette is published in subject category 'volumes' according to the category selected at the time a notice is lodged.

The NSW legislation website contains a permanent archive of past gazettes. The website's collection of gazettes for browsing and searching dates from 2001.

Copies of the Gazette prior to 2001 are available at the State Library of New South Wales (www.sl.nsw.gov.au) or can be browsed online via the National Library of Australia's Trove collection.
