Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to require certain transportation service providers to be tested for, and vaccinated against, COVID-19 before they provide a transportation service to a person who—

- (a) arrives in New South Wales by aircraft, and
- (b) has been outside Australia or New Zealand in the previous 14 days.

2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 2) 2021

(1) Clause 12 Directions—testing of designated transportation providers

Omit clause 12(1)(a). Insert instead—

- (a) who, in the course of the person's employment, provides a transportation service to a relevant person, and

(2) Clause 20E Directions—COVID-19 vaccination

Omit clause 20E(1)(b). Insert instead—

- (b) who, in the course of the person's employment, provides a transportation service to a relevant person, or
