The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 4) 2020* to address concerns about certain people travelling to New South Wales from New Zealand.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Air Transportation Quarantine) Order (No 4) Amendment (New Zealand Arrivals) Order 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences at 12.01am on 18 February 2021.

3 Clause 3 Definitions

Omit the definitions of *relevant flight crew member* and *relevant person* from clause 3(1).

Insert instead—

relevant flight crew member means—

- (a) a flight crew member who—
 - (i) arrives in New South Wales by aircraft, whether the flight originates interstate or overseas, as a flight crew member, and
 - (ii) has, within 14 days immediately before the crew member's arrival, been in a country other than Australia or New Zealand, or
- (b) a flight crew member who arrives in New South Wales by aircraft from New Zealand and a second person on the aircraft, whether a crew member or passenger, has, within 14 days immediately before the crew member's arrival, been in a country other than Australia or New Zealand.

relevant person means—

- (a) a person who—
 - (i) arrives in New South Wales by aircraft, whether the flight originates interstate or overseas, and
 - (ii) has, within 14 days immediately before the person's arrival, been in a country other than Australia or New Zealand, or
- (b) a person who arrives in New South Wales by aircraft from New Zealand and a second person on the aircraft, whether a crew member or passenger, has, within 14 days immediately before the first person's arrival, been in a country other than Australia or New Zealand, or
- (c) a relevant flight crew member.
