## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health (COVID-19 Care Services) Order (No 2) 2022* to remove restrictions on visitors to residential aged care facilities.

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Care Services) Order (No 2) Amendment (No 1) Order 2022*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order commences at the beginning of 18 July 2022.

## **Schedule 1      Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Care Services) Order (No 2) 2022**

**[1]    Clause 6 Introduction**

Insert at the end of clause 6—

**Note—** The operator of a residential aged care facility must consider the advice of the Chief Health Officer in relation to certain matters, including the management of visitors to the facility. See the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) 2022*, clause 9.

**[2]    Clause 9 Restrictions on visitors to residential aged care facilities**

Omit the clause.

**[3]    Clauses 12 and 15**

Omit “clause 7, 8 or 9(3)” wherever occurring in clauses 12(1) and (2) and 15(2).

Insert instead “clause 7 or 8”.

**[4]    Clause 13 Exemptions for medical contraindications**

Omit “9(3),”.
