Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health (COVID-19 Gathering Restrictions) Order 2021* to provide that the Minister may not grant an exemption to the requirement in clause 26A of the Order that contact details provided under clause 25 may be used only for the purposes of contact tracing during the COVID-19 pandemic.
